2. TEAM STRUCTURE**A. Membership**

1. The Land Use Area of Expertise Team is divided into three membership categories:
 - a. Full member (campus and field staff)
 - i. A full member must be active with the AoE Team and must do at least four of the six items listed below on an ongoing basis:
 - a) Participate in production of AoE Team materials
 - b) Perform programing beyond his or her "home" county or as a multi-county agent. (A County Extension Agent, or an agent for a county, should spend at least 20% of his or her time on land use programs outside of his or her home county.)
 - c) Actively serve on AoE Team ad hoc and standing committees.
 - d) Attend AoE Team meetings regularly (at least four out of every six meetings).
 - e) Identify Land Use as an education initiative in the Education Information System (EIS).
 - f) For field staff, attend nine to 14 days, out of the 18 to 22 Extension in-service days per year¹, on land use topics. For campus based staff, maintain land use as the principal topic of research and extension activities.
 - b. Associate member (campus and field staff)
 - i. Any faculty/staff person can be an associate member by signing up on the AoE Team electronic mail list serve.
 - c. Affiliate member.
 - i. Persons and/or organizations outside of MSUE or MSU may be on the AoE Team list serve. Generally, these are individuals or groups interested in AoE Team activities. Affiliate members may collaborate on specific AoE Team projects or programs, provide feedback on AoE Team projects or programs, and/or serve as information resources.
2. Only full members have access to use AoE Team funds, except that an Associate member may receive financial help for land use in-service if he or she is actively pursuing full membership.
